

Volunteers Needed for City of Clayton ADA Advisory Committee

As an initial step in the implementation of the City of Clayton's Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Transition Plan, approved by the City Council on April 1, 2008, the City seeks to establish an ADA Advisory Committee comprised of representatives from both City government and Clayton residents. Two members of the Maintenance Department will represent the City and we hope to include three members of the citizenry to represent the public.

Once established, the ADA Advisory Committee will meet on a monthly basis to discuss issues related to disability and access. The Advisory Committee is also charged with specific responsibilities related to the removal of barriers and improvement of access along the City's Pedestrian Rights of Way. The Advisory Committee shall make recommendations regarding the selection and prioritization of barrier removal projects and is also responsible for the development and oversight of the City of Clayton's Community Outreach Program. The Community Outreach Program is intended to seek input from the public regarding the City's ongoing barrier removal efforts.

With this in mind, the City of Clayton's ADA Coordinator, Rick Angrisani, hereby invites all interested citizens to review the ADA Transition Plan (*link to PDF*) and requests volunteers from the public to help the City implement this Plan.

Once you have reviewed the Plan, if you would like to volunteer for the ADA Advisory Committee, please send a letter to Mr. Angrisani and provide the following information (at a minimum):

- Do you, or does someone you know and/or advocate for, have a disability?
